### **Landscape Technician**

**Job Summary:** Reads plans and interprets landscape designs to install and maintain landscape environments and construction. Can also be certified/licenced to perform specialist functions to construct and maintain landscape environments. Also plans and interprets landscape designs to install and maintain landscape environments and construction. Duties also include maintaining landscape environments.

#### **Major Responsibilities:**

- Work under the direction of a qualified trained Crew Supervisor
- Prepare soil; plant bulbs, plants and seeds
- Dig, cut and transplant trees, shrubs, flowers and plants.
- Plant bushes, shrubs, trees, flowers and plants in a strategic pattern designed by a landscape architect or designer;
- Plan and schedule planting that will thrive in different weather conditions;
- Assist in the construction of walkways, patios, retaining walls and landscape features;
- Maintain landscape environments by pruning, mowing, edging, trimming, fertilizing and watering;
- Interact with clients and propose new ideas or options for dealing with plant, lawn or tree disease or deterioration;
- Assist in planning and organizing the job, ensuring that sufficient resources and material are available and that the job is completed in the most time efficient manner;
- May perform specialist functions based on certification or licence to ensure the health of lawns, trees, shrubs, bushes, flowers and plants.
- Follow all health & safety regulations including wearing appropriate protective equipment and following Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for safe handling of fertilizers, herbicides and other dangerous chemicals
- Ensure safe certification of training on all equipment/machines in question through GoGreenius.
- May operate tractors and other machinery and equipment
- Perform brush cutting and other production tasks as directed.
- Report all incidents / accidents to your direct Crew Supervisor.
- Responsible for housekeeping of work space.
- Reports all vacations and sick days to Crew Supervisor.
- Responsible for overall company image (Courtland shirts, hats, beige cargo pants)
- Responsible for maintaining accurate time records on Viasys.
- Responsible for reporting all safety issues to your direct Crew Supervisor.
